Andrea called meeting to order at 6:00.

Andrea appoints Mike as full board member for Harold.

Pat motions to accept the minutes. Peter seconds. All in favor, motion passes. Sandy abstains due to absence; minutes from 1/22/2014 are accepted.

Andrea opens discussion of Franz Szakmary's gravel pit. Dave motions to make the attorney's response public. Andrea seconds, all in favor. The Planning Board reviewed the responses from both Mary Pinkham-Langer at DRA and Attorney Paul Sanderson at NH Municipal Association. Both responses indicate the next step is to call the Planning Board attorney. Pat feels a call to DES is also in order and requests Dawn research who the gravel pit contact is at DES. Pat motions to call Jae Whitelaw and to proceed with the next step. Peter seconds, all in favor, motion passes.

David Ash is before the Board to inquire about permits needed to start a Lion's Club here in Bethlehem. The Lion's Club does not meet in one set place, and instead moves their meeting around, and therefore there is no building/site involved. Mr. Ash was approached by a number of Bethlehem citizens who requested he consider opening a Lion's Club chapter here in Bethlehem so the town could access grant money to help fund youth programs such as the town pool, and eye exams at both BES and Profile. Pat wonders what kind of permit is needed. Andrea agrees, she does not feel a permit is necessary. Mr. Ash has the Planning Board's consent to move forward.
