We are proud to be able to continue to provide you with reliable curbside trash and recycling service free of charge as a tax-free benefit of our operations here in Bethlehem for 2023. Below you will find additional important information to ensure that your trash and recycling continues to be handled in the safest, most environmentally sound way possible.

Continuing into 2023, the Trudeau Road Transfer Station will provide a Food Waste drop off service as well as Trudeau Treasures swap shop, Apparel Impact clothing box and the new US Flag drop box. Look for details in future mailings. Please remember to place your containers at the curb the morning of your collection day with the lids closed.

## **2023 Observed Holidays**

There will be no curbside service on Monday, December 25, in observance of the Christmas holiday. Trudeau Road Residential Trash & Recycling Transfer Station Hours of Operations: Tuesday – Thursday 7:00 AM – 1:00 PM and Saturday 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM. Please note that the Transfer Station hours will be adjusted in observance of the following holidays; Closed on Independence Day, July 4 and Thanksgiving, November 23.

All Bethlehem residents can drop off trash, recyclable material, electronics, tires, and bulky waste for **FREE** at the Trudeau Road Transfer Station. Construction debris is not accepted. No commercial or industrial enterprises allowed. Please bring two forms of identification for proof of residency to receive your 2023 sticker.

## **FREE Household Hazardous Waste Disposal**

Do you have household hazardous items you need to discard? Bring them to Bethlehem's Annual FREE Household Hazardous Waste Day at the Trudeau Road Transfer Station on September 9th from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM.

Casella has contracted proper disposal of these items at no charge to Bethlehem residents (valid sticker or proof of residency required.) Recycle Better™ Toss ONLY approved Zero-Sort® recyclables in your container to ensure service. Contaminated recycling cannot be recycled and creates additional costs for Casella and the environment.
